European Alliance for Microcredentials

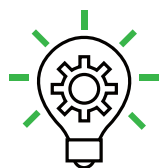

They also support better chances in the labour market, especially for people with less formal education or unsatisfying experiences with their schooling.

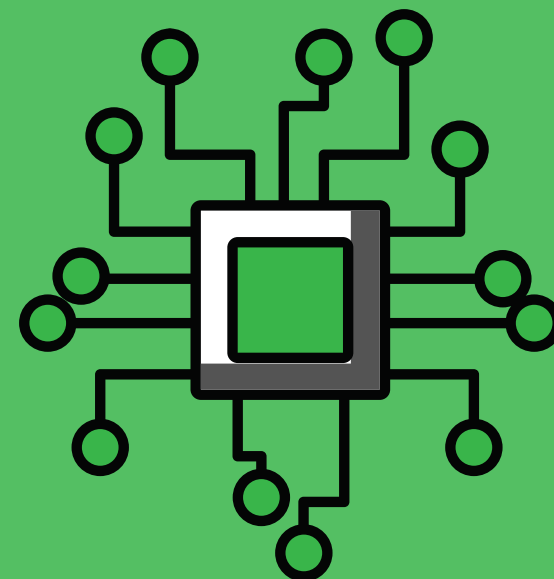
